### **ISCAC Position Memo on HB 532—Conservation License**

#### **The Idaho Sportsman's Caucus Advisory Council (ISCAC) Supports HB 532 for Conservation Licenses**

ISCAC supports the idea of a conservation license requirement for individuals that use Idaho Department of Fish and Game (IDFG) administered lands at no cost and do not purchase a hunting, fishing, or trapping license.

ISCAC believes in the philosophy of the users of the resource supporting the cost to manage, administer and maintain the resource.

A conservation license would create a mechanism for the non-hunting, fishing and trapping public that uses IDFG managed and maintained facilities to financially support the lands, programs, and services that they currently use for free.
